- Please continue to help support your child in writing their name (see name card for correct letter formation).
- Practise reading sound and word cards in your child's book bag wallet.
- Practise to recognise, order and count 1-10, both numbers and objects.
- Go on a welly walk and explore Somerton. How many superheroes can you find?
- Support your child's understanding of our local superheroes through story books, toys and role play.
