Find out about the lives and works of artists who have painted seaside scenes.

View nature programmes about oceans, seas and coasts such as Blue Planet I and II by David Attenborough.

Enjoy family seaside-themed films such as Finding Nemo, Finding Dory, Shark Tale and The Little Mermaid and find out about the featured creatures contained within the films.

Take the opportunity to visit the nearby coastline/seaside and enjoy a walk; perhaps learn to skim a stone, search in rock pools for creatures, fly a kite, catch a fish in a net and jump over waves on the shore!

Make a scrapbook of exciting and interesting items that you collect on a seaside or coastal visit.

Find your own ideas for ways to create seaside art that you may be able to share with the class.

What are the impacts of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way our bodies function?


In what ways are nutrients and water transported within animals and humans?
