Dear Parents and Carers

I would like to thank you for your patience, understanding and support whilst the school has been closed over the last two days due to the red weather warning.

We appreciate that school closures can cause disruption to family routines and childcare arrangements. Please be assured that this decision was not taken lightly. The safety and wellbeing of our pupils, staff and wider school community is always our highest priority, and we carefully considered all available information and carried out a detailed risk assessment before making the decision to close.

Whilst tomorrow is still forecast to be a hot day, the red weather warning is no longer in place and temperatures are not expected to reach the extreme levels forecast for Wednesday and Thursday. We are therefore pleased to confirm that the school will be open as normal on Friday 26th June, and we look forward to welcoming the children back.

To help children remain as comfortable as possible throughout the day, we are encouraging all pupils to attend school in their PE kit. Please also ensure that children bring a sun hat, a named water bottle and that sun cream has been applied before school where appropriate. We will be limiting the amount of time that the children are outside as on Monday and Tuesday.
