Dear Parents and Carers

I hope that you are all getting into the festive spirit on the run-up to Christmas. I am writing to remind you of the school festivities that are taking place over the final two weeks of term:

- Monday 5<sup>th</sup> December: A theatre company is visiting school to provide workshops and to perform the Panto "The Wind in the Willows" for all the children. Owlets, EYFS and KS1 children will watch the performance in the morning and KS2 will watch in the afternoon. This event has been generously funded by the PTFA.
- Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> December: KS1 Nativity performances at 2.00pm in the school hall.
- Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> and Friday 9<sup>th</sup> December: EYFS Nativity performances at 2.15pm in the school hall. **Tickets have already been distributed for all Nativity performances.**
- Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December: School choir to perform at the CLP Carol Concert at HEA at 5.30pm.
- Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> December: KS2 Carol Concert at St. Michael's Church at 6.30pm. Space is limited in the church but we ask that you do not arrive any earlier than 6pm. Parents/carers must remain responsible for children until 6.15pm when they should come to the front of the church to meet their teachers. At the end of the concert, we will ask parents/carers to leave the church first and we will bring the children out to you class by class. We ask that the children wear smart uniform for the concert.  
Please note that we will be walking the children down to the church for a rehearsal during the morning of Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December. Please ensure that the children wear warm coats to school on this day.
- Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December: The children will have their Christmas lunch, take part in Christmas activities and play party games in their classrooms. Children are asked to come to school in party clothes for the day.
- Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December: Father Christmas will be visiting all classes during the day. This is also the final day of term.

As in previous years, the children can bring in Christmas cards from home to give to their friends, should they wish. Cards should be brought into school from 8<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> December and put in the school Christmas post boxes for distributing at the end of term.

We look forward to celebrating Christmas with you all at the various performances 😊
