## Forest School – Autumn Term

This term, Forest School sessions will run as follows:

### First Half of Term:

- Monday 8th September – Friday 3rd October:  
Upper Key Stage 2 classes – Red Kites, Buzzards and Peregrines
- Monday 6th October – Thursday 23rd October:  
Key Stage 1 classes – Robins, Puffins and Goldfinches

### Second Half of Term:

- Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November – Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November  
Lower Key Stage 2 classes – Harriers, Sparrowhawks and Kestrels
- Monday 1<sup>st</sup> December – Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December:  
Owlets and Foundation Stage classes, Pipits and Wagtails

### Forest School Clothing Requirements:

- Children should bring their Forest School clothes in a named carrier bag when it is their planned sessions.
- Clothing must be appropriate for the weather – if it's likely to be muddy or wet, please send in warm, old clothing and waterproofs.
- Children must bring wellies and spare socks – even with wellies, feet can get wet!
- Forest School clothes should remain in school for the whole week of their sessions.
