There are lots of ways you can enhance your child's learning at home!





Can you research a country of your choice and find out about food, music, wildlife and traditional stories?

Can you compare and contrast an animal or plant from the UK with one from a totally different climate/country?

Can you compare and contrast different weathers across the globe i.e.: what is the weather like in Australia in December/January? What is the weather like in Antarctica throughout the year?

Can you design a leaflet giving help and advice about how to look after a pet, thinking about its daily needs and care throughout the year i.e.: how does owning certain pets in the summer change to owning them in the winter?

Can you create a collage to represent the different seasons?

Can you draw a detailed illustration of a seasonal plant that is growing in your garden?

Can you create your own world using whatever art materials you have at home?

Some of the questions that we hope to answer this term.

In Topic:

What is a continent? How many are there? What is an ocean? What are the oceans of the world called? What is a human feature? What is a natural feature? How are they similar or different?

What is a compass? What might it be used for?

Where do we find hot and cold areas in the world? What is the Equator? What is climate? What is climate change and how is it caused?

In Science: Animals and their Habitats (Y2) and Plants

What is different about things that are living, dead or have never been alive? What are the names of certain plants and animals in a familiar habitat? Can I sort objects into categories? What is a microhabitat? Can I describe the conditions in a habitat and can I ask questions about different habitats? What are the different characteristics of some plants and animals? Can I describe a food chain?

Can I make careful drawings of plants and trees? Can I follow instructions and plant a seed or bulb? Do I know the life cycle of a plant? Do I know what a plant needs in order to grow well? How do I know that a plant is a living thing?

In Science: Seasonal Changes (Y1)

What are the four seasons? How does the weather change in the four seasons? How does day length change throughout the year?


(The children will learn about working scientifically by making tables and charts about the weather; and set up rain gauges to measure the amount of rainfall. We will also incorporate this with some winter themed art.)

In RE: What do Christians believe about God?

What is the Bible? Why is the Bible special to Christians? What are the Old and New Testaments? What does the Bible tell us about how the world was created? Who were Adam and Eve and what happened to them? How does God want us to treat our world? How does God teach us to be loving, kind and forgiving?

Our Learning Journey







Our journey will start with learning about the seven continents and five oceans of the world. We will then learn about natural and human features of the world. We will move onto work around compasses and to use satellite photographs to identify famous world landmarks. Finally, we will be learning about the different climate zones.



Moving on after half term we will be celebrating all that is great about Britain in our topic 'Made in Britain'. We will discover facts and information about the four nations, capital cities and famous rivers. We will look at how this country is working hard to be more eco-friendly and discover some of the key ways that our country is working to be cleaner and greener.
