

KS2 SATs - helpful maths websites

Times Table Rock Stars - <https://play.ttrockstars.com/>

Times Table Rock Stars (TTRS) is great for times table practice. Children should already know all their times tables (with rapid recall) up to 12×12 , but if they don't, TTRS can help. Even if your child does have rapid recall of their times tables, they can always get quicker!

Mathsbot - <https://mathsbot.com/primary/ks2>

Mathsbot gives the children the opportunity to answer questions in a test which is identical to SATs paper 1. It has the ability to mark the answers online, giving instant feedback.

If you follow this link (<https://mathsbot.com/primary/ks2Mini>), it lets you select a specific style of question that the child can practise, which is particularly good if a child is struggling with certain questions. Click on the question number and it will turn green, then click new. I strongly advise children doing their working out on paper before inputting their answers.
