

2026 Year 5 Residential Trip to PGL Osmington Bay

We are pleased to inform you that we have been able to secure a booking at PGL Osmington Bay for our year 5 pupils. We will depart at approximately 10am on Wednesday,11th March 2026 and return to school at approximately 4pm on Friday, 13th March 2026, taking part in a variety of activities over the three days. The programme has yet to be finalised but could include activities such as sailing, orienteering, climbing and kayaking.

We estimate the total cost of this trip to be £250 depending on the take-up, this will include, transport, accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner (when applicable) each day (you will need to provide a packed lunch for Wednesday), and activities. We hope you will agree that this trip represents excellent value for money.

As with all trips of this kind, our Governing Body have adopted the County Charging Policy. It is important to remember that we do not have separate funds available for such visits and without your support they would not take place. If there is a lack of parental support for this trip it will have to be cancelled.
