Dear Parents and Carers

We hope that you are enjoying the first day of the summer holiday. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you of our expectations around school uniform and PE kit from September. We are sending this now so you have time over the summer to ensure your child is fully prepared for the new academic year.

From September, we expect all children to attend school wearing the correct school uniform on non-PE days, and the appropriate PE kit on their allocated PE days only. We will confirm your child's PE days towards the end of the summer holiday.

It is important that all children come to school looking smart and representing King Ina with pride. A reminder of the correct school uniform and PE kit can be found on our website and is detailed below for your reference:

Blouse/Shirt White short-sleeved polo shirt* or white blouse or white shirt

Jumper/Cardigan Royal blue V-necked knitted jumper* or knitted cardigan*

Skirts/Pinafore Dresses School Tartan Kilts and pinafore dresses are available from South West School Wear, or plain grey

Trousers/Shorts Grey Tailored (not jogging bottoms or leggings)

Socks White, dark grey or black

Tights Grey or Black

Shoes Sensible, in black, or Sandals: brown, black or white. **No boots.**

Dresses Royal blue gingham check

School Tie (Optional) Royal Blue and gold striped

P.E kit Navy blue/black plain shorts (unbranded), white 'T' Shirts, plimsolls ('daps')/trainers, optional royal blue PE Hoodies or navy blue/black plain hoodies/sweatshirts (unbranded), optional navy blue/black plain tracksuit bottoms/joggers (unbranded).

Hair accessories

Jewellery

As it is impossible for staff to be responsible for any jewellery worn by individuals, we request that children do not wear any to school.

For reasons of health and safety children with pierced ears must wear 'studs' only during school time.

Makeup

No makeup or nail varnish or use coloured hair dye.

In addition, please be aware of two important changes starting September 2025:

- Children should not bring their own pencil cases or stationery to school. These items should be kept at home for personal use. School will provide all the resources pupils need for their lessons and playtimes.
- Children will also **not be permitted to bring toys from home**, including fidget toys. These will be provided by the school as needed. We do understand that from time to time, some children may need a small comfort item from home. This will be considered on a case by case basis and should be discussed with your child's class teacher.
