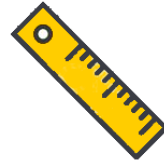

Our Learning Journey

In the first part of this term we will be finding out about Mexico and comparing this to the United Kingdom. We shall be focusing on comparing key physical and human features, culture, climate and food. The main emphasise will be exploring the food of Mexico where we shall be tasting some traditional foods and using our Design Technology lessons to design, make and evaluate our own Mexican dish.

In the second half of the term we shall be focussing on weather explorers. During this topic we shall be identifying seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom. We shall be making links to science and the seasons. This shall involve looking at the daily weather and keeping a diary. We will also be looking at how the weather effects the growth of plants, linking to science.

At the end of the spring term we are going to have a topic day on a mini history unit, exploring the history of the school grounds. We shall we looking at what was found when they started to build the school and looking at the round house on site.
