Dear Parents/Carers,

Rural Life Museum, Glastonbury

We would like to invite Year 5 & 6 to attend a school trip to The Rural Life Museum in Glastonbury as part of our History learning.

We are currently studying World War 2. This trip will be an opportunity for the children to learn more about evacuation and our any local history linking to WWII. **For this trip, we would like the children to get into character by dressing up as an evacuee child.**

The charge for the Rural Life, workshop and coach hire will be £10.35, which has kindly been subsidised by the PTFA. **Please login to Parentpay to pay & give consent for your child to go on the trip.**

As with all trips of this kind the Governing Body has adopted the Council Charging Policy. It is important to remember that we do not have separate funds available for such visits and without your support they would not take place. If there is a lack of parental support for this trip it will have to be cancelled.

The children will go in their classes on three separate days, as follows:

- Tuesday 2nd December – Red Kites
- Tuesday 9th December – Buzzards
- Wednesday 10th December – Peregrines

Children will need to bring a packed lunch, water bottle and coat with them on the day. The children will be back in time for normal pick up at 3.15pm.

The bus will need to leave King Ina C of E Academy at 9.15am to ensure punctual arrival to our location.

It is important to note that going on school trips is subject to the children maintaining the expected standard of behaviour in school. The children will need to demonstrate that they are sensible, make good choices and keep themselves safe in order to participate.
