Dear Parents/Guardians

2026/27 Year 6 Residential Trip to Okehampton

We are pleased to inform you that we have been able to secure a booking at Okehampton for our Year 6 pupils. We will arrive at approximately 11am on Wednesday, 19th May 2027 and leave at 3pm on Friday, 21st May 2027 taking part in a variety of activities over the three days. The programme has yet to be finalised but could include archery, climbing, cycling, gorge scrambling, kayaking, raft building and canoeing.

We estimate the total cost of this trip to be £329 depending on the take-up. The cost includes accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner (when applicable) each day and activities. To reduce this cost we are planning on completing a sponsored walk to pay for the coach costs and this will be deducted from the final instalment once we know how much has been raised. **Children will be required to bring a packed lunch for the first day only.**

As with all trips of this kind, our Governing Body have adopted the County Charging Policy. It is important to remember that we do not have separate funds available for such visits and without your support they would not take place. If there is a lack of parental support for this trip it will have to be cancelled.

If you would like your child/ren to take part in this trip, we will require a non-refundable deposit of £83 by 23rd October 2026, to be paid via ParentPay. The second instalment of £83 by 5th January 2027; the third instalment of £82 will be due 12th February 2027, with the final balance of £81 due by 24th March 2027.

It is important to note that places for this Residential are subject to the children maintaining the expected standard of behaviour throughout the school Year. The children will need to demonstrate that they are sensible, make good choices and keep themselves safe in order to participate.
