We also share updates on Facebook so make sure to join us!

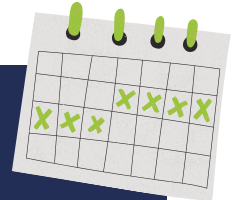
We look forward to continuing to help the children and families of King Ina and we really do hope you'll join us in supporting our wonderful community.

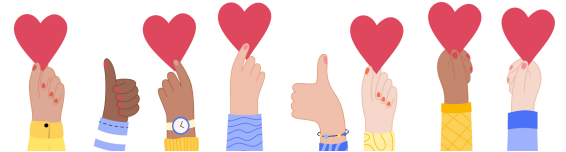
